- Technological Systems Management (70)

- * All majors are offered from bachelor's to doctoral degree except for Business Management
- * Accelerated Program for four engineering majors (bachelor's & master's degree in five years. 3 years in Korea and 2 years in USA)

Required Documents

1) High School Transcript in English

- * Students with GED are strongly recommended to submit SAT/ACT test scores
- * SAT/ACT required for those who graduate from a high school in USA
- * Transfer applicants must submit college transcript in English as well

2) Personal statement in English

- * Word Count Limit: 650 words
- * Applicants are advised to give an explanation about academic gaps if they had any.

3) Recommendation Letter in English or Korean

- * Once the recommender's name and email address are entered when applying online, the letter template and the link through which it will be uploaded will be automatically sent to the recommender

4) English Proficiency Test Scores (Minimum scores given) TOEFL iBT 80 / IELTS Academic 6.5 / (New) SAT ERW 480 / ACT English 19 or above

- * Students without English test scores may apply for Provisional Admission
- * Official English Proficiency Test Scores must be reported through the testing agency (SUNY Korea Institution Code: TOEFL 7499 / SAT & AP 7442 / ACT 7029).

Important reminder

- * All the required documents must be uploaded on the online application.
- * Optional documents include but not limited to additional essay, academic scores (KSAT, IB, AP, etc), any documents which prove extracurricular activities
