Sun, Aug. 27	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Semester Cancellation:</b> Last day students can drop all classes via <a href="#">SOLAR</a>.</li> </ul>
Mon, Aug. 28	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Semester Start:</b> First day of Monday classes</li> <li>• <b>Late Registration:</b> \$50 fee if not enrolled in at least one class before semester start.</li> </ul>

Changes must be processed by 4:00 PM. Non-petitionable.</li> <li>• <b>Course Withdrawal:</b> Last day students can process a <a href="#">withdrawal</a> from individual course(s) via <a href="#">SOLAR</a>. "W" (withdrawal) will be recorded on transcript. Changes must be processed by 4:00 pm</li> </ul>
Wed, Dec. 6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Correction Day:</b> Classes follow Friday's schedule (<b>No Wednesday classes in session</b>)</li> </ul>
Thur, Dec. 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>LOA/Term Withdrawal:</b> Last day to take a leave of absence or withdraw from the University. Students must submit the Semester Withdrawal Form</li> <li>• <b>Classes End:</b> Last day of classes</li> </ul>
