- Portfolio should be composed of 4 elements: 1 essay, 2 design projects, 1 sewing project.

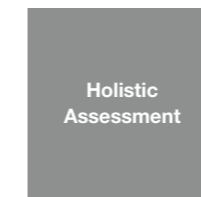

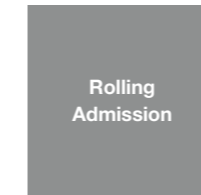

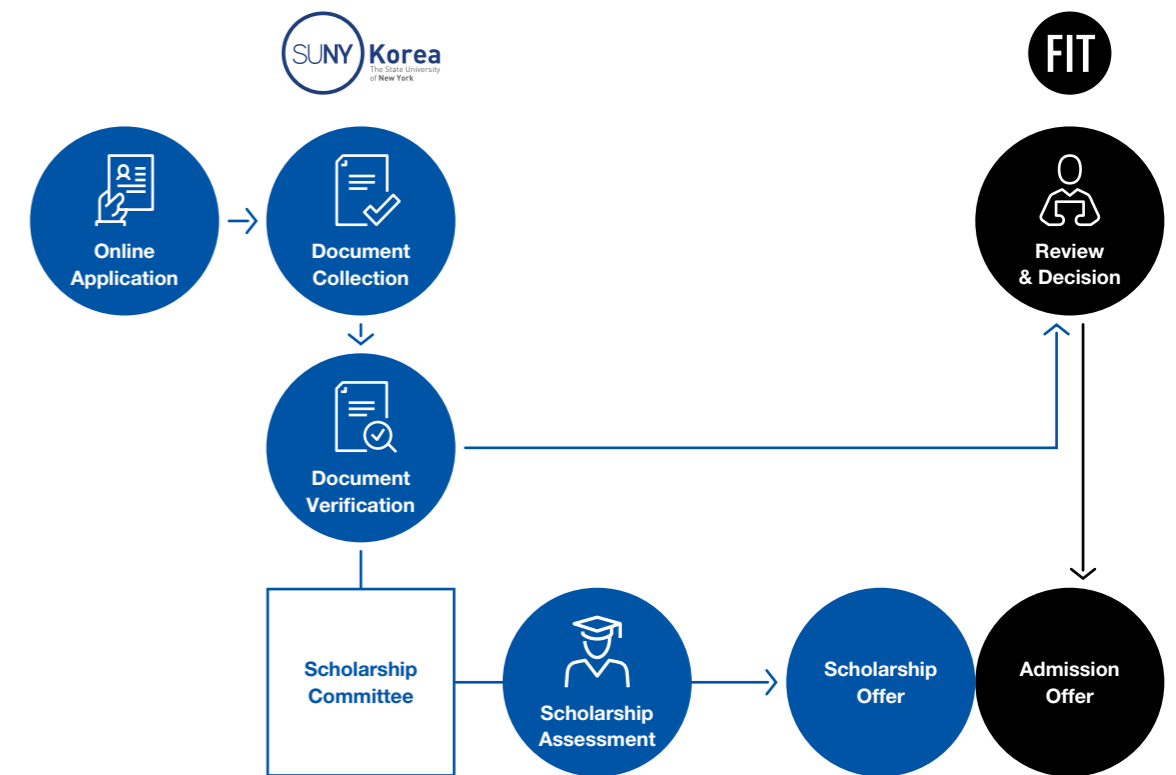
