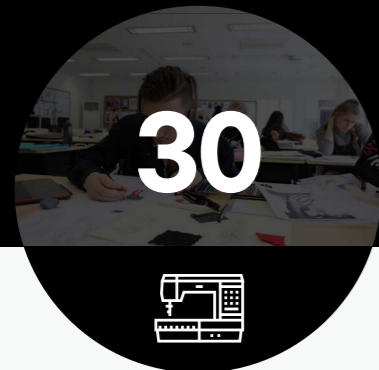

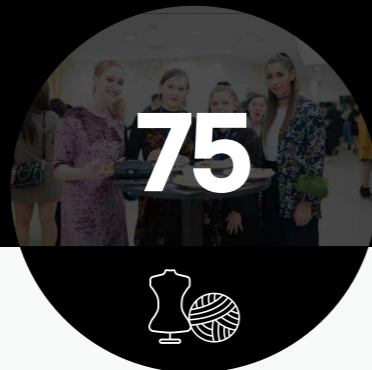
SCHEDULE & QUOTA

APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Required

✓ High School Transcript/Certificate of Graduation 01

- Korean/US GED is accepted; GED-certified applicants are recommended to submit other credentials.
- Applicants for transfer admissions are required to submit the academic transcript of the college/university they attended.
- Applicants are required to send the original copies of academic transcripts to FIT New York Campus.

✓ Personal Statement 02

- A form is provided in the online application on the SUNY Korea webpage. (Word count limit: 750)
- Applicants with gap years are recommended to provide relevant explanations.

✓ English Test Score 03

- Minimum Requirement & Institution Code

Test	Minimum Score	Institution Code
TOEFL (iBT)	80	2257
IELTS	6.5	Fashion Institute of Technology
DET (Duolingo)	105	Fashion Institute of Technology

- Official reporting through the testing agency must be completed by the given deadline.
- English test score requirement is waived for applicants who completed 4 years (9~12th grades), excluding ESL courses, in secondary schools in the United States.

✓ Portfolio (Applicable to Fashion Design Applicants only) 04

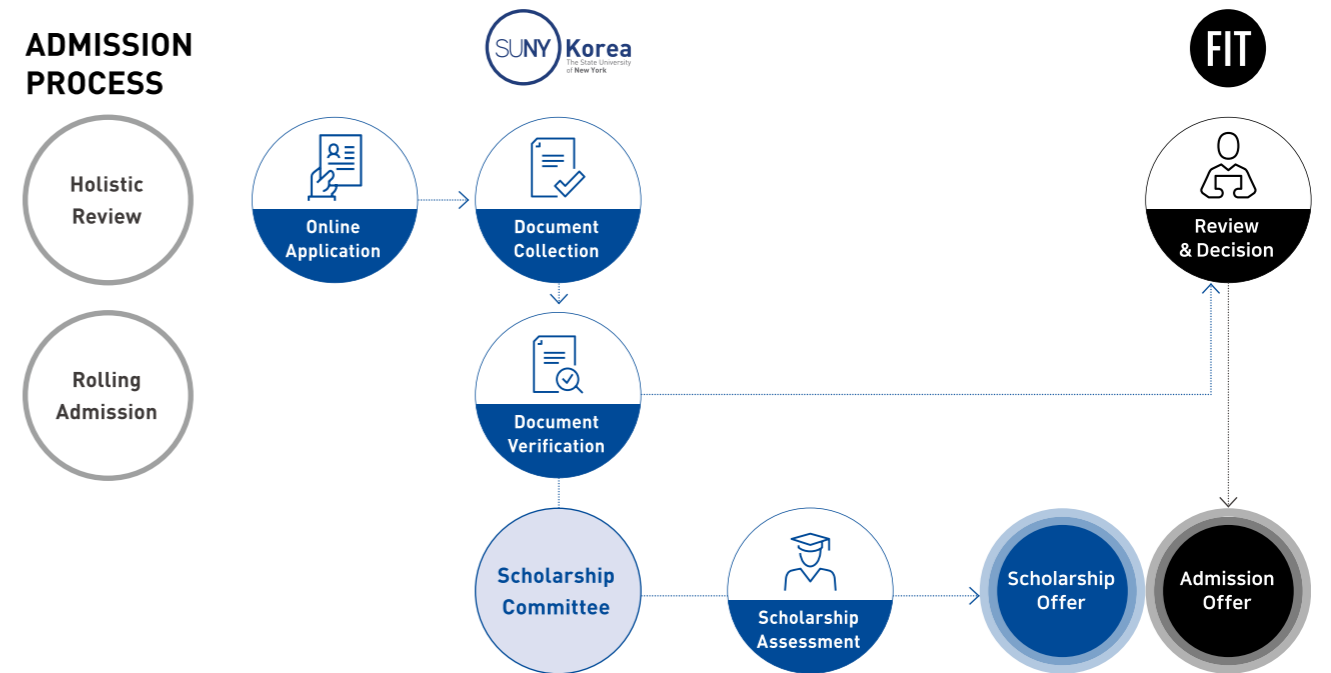
- Individual portfolio must be submitted directly to FIT New York via SlideRoom. (Link will be provided separately)
- Portfolio should be composed of 4 elements: 1 essay, 2 design projects, 1 sewing project.

Optional

✓ Supplementary Documents

- Other credentials, such as SAT, ACT, AP/IB, College Scholastic Ability Test, high school portfolio, certificates, awards, etc.

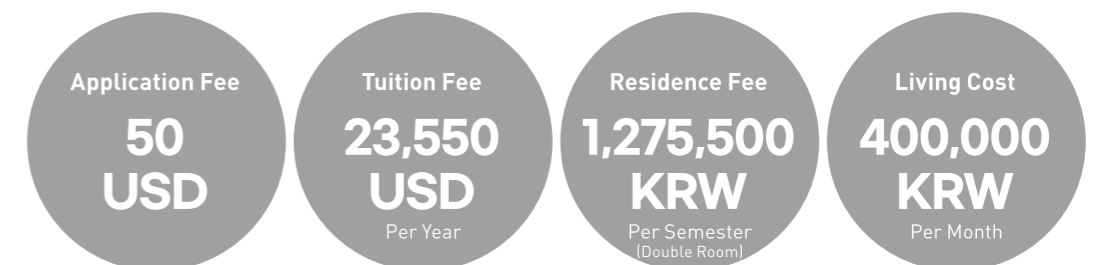
