About IFWY

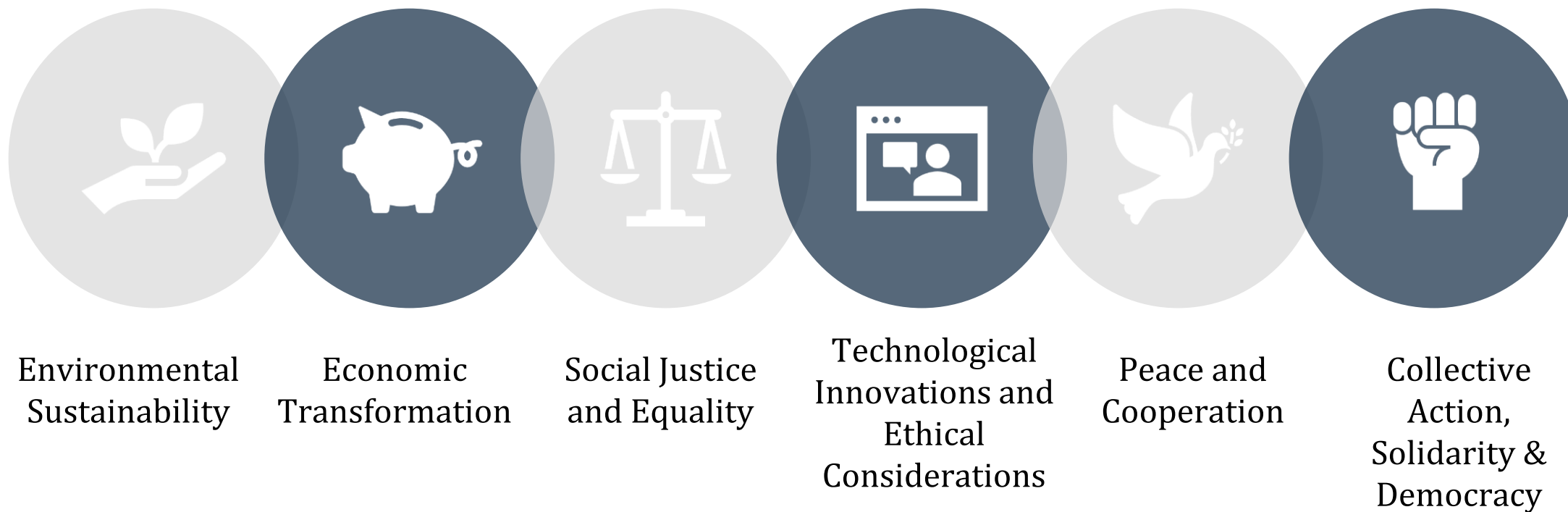
The International Forum We, the Youth (IFWY) represents a bold and new model of youth engagement for social change.

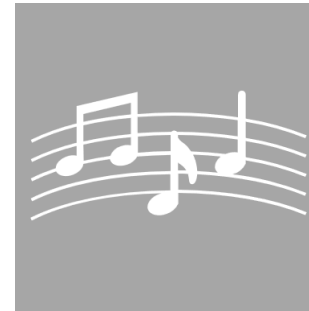

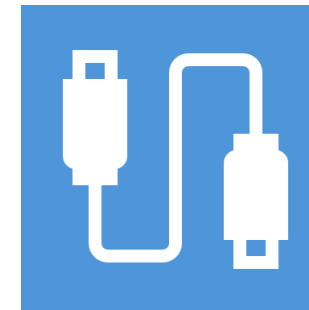

2025 Korean Dialogue without Borders

- Korean Dialogue for the Nomination of Youth Delegates to the Final Conference in Seoul
 - A two-day dialogue to nominate youth representatives who will attend the Final Conference in Seoul, engage in global policy discussions, and present youth-driven policy recommendations at major international events such as WSSD and the G20.
- **Forum Details**
 - Date: 11 – 12 October 2025 - Venue: MBC Training Center (Gyeonggi-do, Yangju-si)
 - All program activities will be conducted in English.
- **Who Can Apply**
 - Young people (aged 18–35)
 - Must be of Korean heritage and
Currently residing in the Republic of Korea, or Holding Korean citizenship
- **Application deadline** : 26 September 2025, Friday

How to Participate

1. Create an account on the IFWY website (www.ifwy.org)
2. Briefly introduce yourself and share your motivation for joining IFWY
3. Share your idea in the 'Idea Hub' by selecting a topic of interest and submitting a policy idea
 - **【 Idea Hub 】 → 【 Regions: Korean Dialogue Without Border 】**
 - Browse ideas submitted by other participants — you can “like” and comment on them

Nomination Process

- Policy ideas submitted to the Idea Hub on the IFWY website will be reviewed
 - Peer endorsement (number of “likes” from fellow applicants) & gender, themes, and regional balance
- 50 participants will join the Korean Dialogue
 - 25 youth delegates will be nominated through peer evaluation during the Korean Dialogue and will join the Final Conference in Seoul and have opportunities to participate in international forums.

- Announcement of nominated participants: Scheduled for 30 September 2025
- Individual notifications for Korean Dialogue: 30 September 2025
 - Details will include travel and accommodation support, as well as preparation guidelines for the forum

Participant Support

- Travel Support: Round-trip KTX (economy-class) from your place of residence to Seoul
- Accommodation Support: 1 nights (11 October 2025 /Sat)
- Meals and Refreshments: Includes breakfast and additional meals during the program.
