- A minimum of one semester completed at SUNY Korea
- At least one full academic year remaining to serve as an Ambassador
- Community Service
- Strong communication and leadership skills
- Enthusiastic and positive personality
- A sincere desire to represent SUNY Korea
- The ability to work well with others and to be a successful team player
- Keen knowledge of the University

■ Commitment of Student Ambassador Program

- Maintenance of a 3.0 GPA
- Assisting with the events run by SUNY Korea Admissions such as the information session
 - > Serving as hosts at a variety of high profile events on campus: meeting, greeting, and escorting visitors
 - > Providing campus tours to guest
 - Answering general questions regarding SUNY Korea
 - Doing basic administrative tasks for outreach and recruitment activities under the direction of a member of University staff

- Supporting both commencement (Fall & Spring) and convocation (Fall & Spring) in any administrative or organizational duties that are deemed suitable.
